Enrollment and Recruitment Efforts

- Edge flyers and print materials are available at EON Youth Lounge on 4th Avenue which is operated by Southern Arizona AIDS Foundation.
- Edge flyers and print materials are available at El Rio Community Health Centers.
- Charter School Capital has increased digital ads on social media platforms for both campuses.
- Charter School Capital paying for bus stop ads on benches and shelters.
- Edge is using leftover Disneyland tickets the school earned through Disney's
 Points of Light program to incentivize students recruiting their friends and

family to enroll. Student names were drawn at both campuses this week, with a student from each campus winning four tickets to Disneyland.

In the last month....

- On Wednesday, September 14th Southern Arizona AIDS Foundation and the University of Arizona were on campus providing free HIV tests to interested students.
- On Wednesday, September 7th and Thursday, September 15th, the Pima County Health Department was on campus providing free COVID-19 vaccinations. Between the two events a total of 40 people received vaccinations. Students, staff, parents and guardians, and a few alumni were vaccinated.
- After school clubs started and are held after school on Mondays. Caydan Hammer (English teacher) facilitates a board game club. Bonnie Craig (Art teacher and ELA TA) facilitates an art club. Between the two clubs roughly 30 students participate in after school clubs.
- A Parent Teacher Conference was held on Wednesday, September 7th. A total of 15 families attended, representing 19 different Edge students.
- One of our priorities this semester is to meet with all parents and guardians this school year. So far this quarter, we have met with 29 different families.
 * This does not include the families that attended Parent Teacher Conferences.
- Another priority was to ensure that all Himmel Park students gained exposure to BASE Education, which serves as our online Emotional Intelligence curriculum. Over the past month Himmel Park students have logged over 80 hours in the Emotional Intelligence curriculum. We are implementing the Emotional Intelligence curriculum as weekly bell work in Social Studies and Science classes. Students have completed courses in the following topics: Healthy Relationships, Healthy Communication, Stress Management, Anxiety, Motivation, Self-Esteem, and Setting Goals.

Monsoons and high humidity have resulted in several roof leaks. It is both a

policy, we are currently seeking bids and will move forward with repairs.
