Arizona Department of Education Site Visit on Tuesday, February 7th

Ken Rausch, our Education Program Specialist, from the Arizona Department of Education, visited both Edge campuses as part of the bi-annual requirement for schools in school improvement status. This was Ken's second visit of the year. Ken met with school leadership to our progress towards our goals on our Integrated Action Plan (IAP) and hear about our successes and areas of growth of this school year. He also observed classrooms at each campus and held a focus group with our staff. He will also be reviewing survey data from students and their support persons. Once he reviews the survey data he will send his summary reports for his site visits to Edge campuses, which will include recommendations for continued growth. His summary reports will be emailed to board members and Edge staff once we receive them. In an email Ken sent us the day after the site visit, he said:

"Visiting Edge Schools is one of the best parts of my job because I get to see the dedication and hard work of all the staff as they work to teach and support the students."

Support Person Surveys Administered

Over the past two weeks we have had students and support persons (parents, guardians, and positive adult supports of our students) complete Stakeholder Feedback Surveys. Our leadership team and staff will analyze the survey results. Results from the survey help inform decision making as it relates to school. improvement goals, grant writing, and program implementation and evaluation. Results will be emailed to board members.

Edge like many high schools, struggle to engage support persons in completing surveys. However, we are proud to report that both Edge campuses have their highest percentage of support persons surveys completed in over 10 years!

Edge Northwest had a goal of 20 completed support person surveys, and had 29 completed, which represents 50% of our support person population. Edge Himmel Park had a goal of 25 completed support person surveys, and had 43 submitted, which represents 40% of its support person population!

Solar Grant Vendor Selection

Back in the Fall Semester, Edge was awarded \$151,200 grant through the Community Foundation of Southern Arizona (CFSA) to go solar. Anne Ortiz, along with former board members Gloria Proo and Claire Schueren wrote the grant. A total of six different vendors submitted a Request For Proposal (RFP). Grant recipients including Edge, received support through CFSA and Solar United Neighbors to evaluate the RFPs. Edge has selected Technicians For Sustainability (TFS) as its vendor. The grant will allow for the construction of solar-paneled covered parking in the north parking lot of Edge Himmel Park along the fence line. The project will be completed by September of 2023.
