#### **Enrollment and Recruitment Efforts**

- Four tabling events scheduled at multiple Eegee's locations. (Former grads, Baylee Decker, and Matt King serving as Edge ambassadors at the events)
- Rob met with Lapan College & Career Club regarding an expanded partnership. Edge facilitated a virtual information session with 6 students who attend Lapan's after school program.

### Career Day Schedule for Friday, September 27th

## **Update On School Improvement Grant**

As a reminder, Edge was notified on August 22<sup>nd</sup> by the Arizona Department of Education, that Edge and other "small schools" would receive a maximum of \$40,000. The grant was written for \$350,000.

The reason for the shortfall in grant allocations was that ADE needed to revert \$29 million in school improvement grant funding after the department failed to spend it in time. ADE has applied for a waiver from the U.S. Department of Education. That waiver is likely to be granted. How ADE will disperse any additional funds made available by the Federal waiver is still up in the air. We don't anticipate our grant application to be fully funded. We anticipate learning about additional funding in mid-October.

#### Actions steps Edge has taken includes:

- Contacted the Arizona Charter School Association who has a lobbying arm to their organization and leverage with ADE and the state legislature.
- Emailed letters to the Arizona Associate Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- Contacted Edge's legal counsel
- Submitted feedback to ADE as part of their 30-day public comment period.

The media in Maricopa County has given much attention to this debacle. Governor Hobbs has ordered "an audit of Superintendent Horne's mismanagement of public-school funding."
