# **Himmel Park Admin Report**

August 19, 2025

### **FY 26 Enrollment**

Himmel Park: 81 students (66 returning + 26 new – 11 expected withdrawals, all from FY25)

Northwest: 41 students (38 returning + 14 new – 11 expected withdrawals, all from FY25)

Total: 122 students

\*Budget written at 150 students\*

### **Enrollment Comparison to FY25 start:**

- Himmel Park began FY25 with 70 + 32 new 8 withdrawals = 94, and added another 9 in weeks 2-6 (6 stayed all year).
- Northwest began FY25 with 45 + 14 new 3 withdrawals = 56, and added another 8 in weeks 2-6 (4 stayed all year).

We anticipate additional enrollment growth in the upcoming weeks, consistent with prior-year trends.

### **Partnerships & Programs**

#### COPE Community Services to teach 1st quarter elective class at Edge Northwest.

COPE Community Services will teach a class focused on destignatizing mental health at Edge Northwest this quarter. The curriculum called *Hiding In Plain Sight* confronts the issues of stigma, discrimination, awareness, and silence about mental health, and, in doing so, helps advance a shift in the public perception of mental health issues today.

### La Frontera Arizona to have a weekly presence at Edge Himmel Park

La Frontera Arizona, whose Teen Center is located at Speedway and Country Club, will have a weekly presence at Edge Himmel Park this school year. La Frontera staff will be available 1 day a week to provide coping skills and assist interested students and their support people in connecting to their services. La Frontera offers 1on1 therapy, group therapy, and assistance with applying for AHCCCS.
