#### **Student Appreciation Event - November 22nd**

On Tuesday, November 22nd, Edge staff will host a student appreciation event in recognition of students' positive engagement and contributions to our school community. It's a short week of just two instructional days before Thanksgiving Break. We intentionally planned a community-building activity to reinforce student belonging, connection, and motivation.

To express appreciation, staff will prepare and serve a variety of homemade soups, stews, and chilis during lunch. The intent of the event is to acknowledge students for their resilience, effort, and daily presence, as they remain the primary source of purpose and inspiration for our staff. The event will also serve as a relationship-strengthening activity aligned with our culture-building goals.

Student feedback from past iterations of the event has been positive, and staff reported that the informal, shared experience fostered a meaningful connection going into the holiday break. Board members are invited to attend from 12PM-1PM on Tuesday, November 22<sup>nd</sup>.

#### **Reduction In Workforce**

A reduction in the workforce has been implemented due to lower-than-expected student enrollment for the current academic year and the resulting budget deficit. After a review of staffing levels, course coverage needs, and projected year-end financial impact, one instructional math position at Edge Himmel Park has been eliminated.

Enrollment for FY25–26 finalized below projected targets, resulting in a budget shortfall that requires personnel adjustments to maintain fiscal responsibility. Non-salary reductions were prioritized and implemented first; however, staffing reductions became necessary to ensure a balanced operational plan while preserving required programming, student services, and compliance with state academic requirements.

The staffing reduction was not performance-based. Notification and separation procedures were carried out in person, in writing, and in accordance with school policy, contractual guidelines, and applicable regulations.

#### **Remembering Steve Nutt**

Steven Nutt was a 9th-grade student at Edge Himmel Park. We were deeply saddened to learn that Steven died by suicide at his home on Friday, October 24th. His mother notified Edge on Monday, October 27th, and staff were informed that same day. On Tuesday, October 28th, grief counselors from Tu Nidito and Marana Unified School District were on campus to

support both students and staff. Steven was known for his energy, curiosity, and genuine effort to learn his peers' names and make connections.

A memorial service was held in his honor on November 8th, attended by nearly all Edge Himmel Park staff along with 11 students. In his memory, a scholarship fund was established, and to date, \$2,200 has been donated.

#### **Grant Submission Update**

Edge has continued to pursue diversified funding to support student wellness, programming, and organizational sustainability. The following grant applications have been submitted:
